This book is designed as a graduate-level text in econometric methods. It is well written with a wide and fairly detailed coverage of the literature. It should be considered for adoption by all graduate-level teachers but will have particular appeal for those who use books like those of *J. Johnston* [Econometric methods, 2nd ed., McGraw-Hill (1972)] or *G. G. Judge, R. C. Hill, W. E. Griffiths, H. Lütkepohl, and T.-C. Lee* [Introduction to the theory and practice of econometrics, Wiley (1982)] as their undergraduate texts.
